The skeleton found is from a young adult who appears to have not gone through puberty yet.	Genetic analysis indicates that the skeleton has XY chromosomes.	Bone density and shape suggests that this person's primary sex hormone was estrogen.
Two skeletons are buried together with a shawl wrapped around them. This shawl has been found in other sites known to belong to married couples.	The clothing found on some human remains includes jewelry and patterns typical of men in other tombs from the same time period.	Objects found in the tomb include sewing supplies. Sewing in this culture during this time period was primarily done by women.
