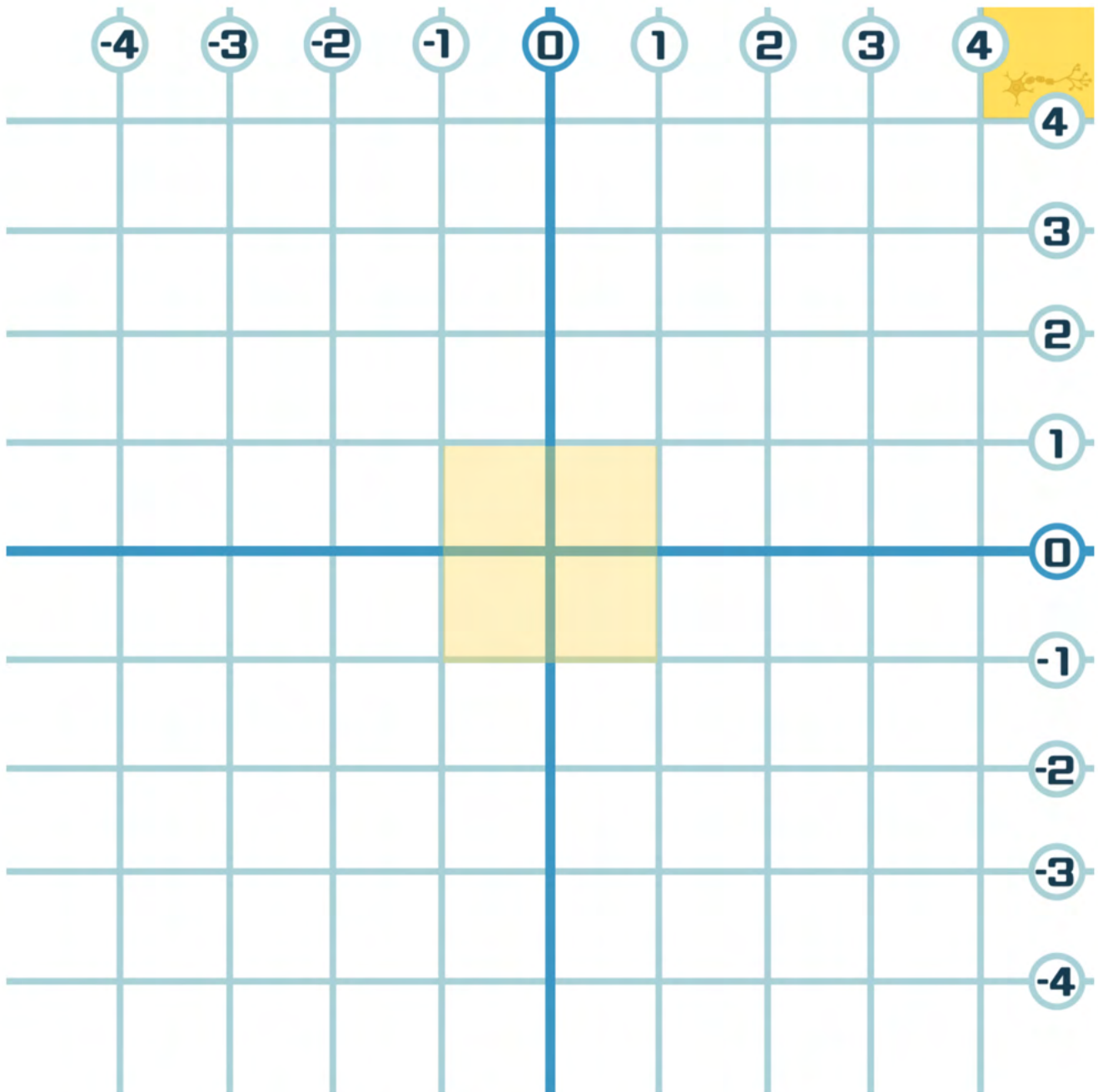


First, you will need to figure out the order of the steps to a dance using the attached cards. Then, you need to move through that pattern on the grid below. You must start and end in the yellow square in the center. A secret code will be revealed.



For older learners.

Print and cut out all six cards.
